4 Ms. Priyanka Patel, an advocate practicing in this court, is appointed as Commissioner to record evidence in the matter. The fees, administrative expenses of the Commissioner together with typing charges and venue charges, if any, to be shared equally between the plaintiff and defendant no.1 and the same will be costs in the suit. The fees of the Commissioner is fixed at Rs.3,500/- per hour.

5 The Commissioner to endeavor to complete recording of evidence of PW-1 by 28th February, 2017. The Commissioner to fix minimum two/three dates per session for cross examination of PW-1. If the parties do not respond promptly within 48 hours of receiving a communication from the Commissioner suggesting the subsequent dates, the Commissioner to go ahead and fix the dates convenient to her and the parties shall make themselves available at the time and dates fixed by the Commissioner. If the plaintiff or the witness does not remain present, the Commissioner should close the evidence of PW-1 and if the defendant does not remain present to cross examine the witness, the defendant's cross examination should be treated closed as no cross. Once the dates are fixed, the Commissioner not to grant adjournment on any ground whatsoever

unless the situation is so grave that it warrants an adjournment and for reasons recorded. Liberty to apply.
