

admissibility and the relevancy of the documents is considered as follows:

1. The death certificate of the deceased is marked **Exhibit-A**.
 2. A copy of the Will of the deceased dated 31st July 1995 is marked **Exhibit-B**.
 3. The registration receipt of the registration of the Will dated 3rd August 1995, being a public document is marked **Exhibit-C**.
 4. Documents from Item Nos.4 to 13 are papers and proceedings in the matter and are not required to be marked exhibits.
 5. Written statement in Administration Suit No. 4437/1997 is not relevant in this suit and is, therefore, not marked.
 6. There are three documents executed by the deceased within a week of the execution of the Will hence they are relevant to the issues in this Suit.
3. The evidence with regard to the execution of these documents is not led. Hence the documents cannot be admitted upon direct oral evidence. Consequently, no further documents are marked in evidence until further affidavit is filed.
