ORDER :

1. This Petition impugns an order dated July 10, 2025, passed by me sitting singly under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (***“the Act”***).

2. Evidently, the Petition is filed under Section 37 of the Act, and would lie before the Division Bench which would hear a challenge to Section 9 orders. Meanwhile, the parties have reached a settlement and therefore, are desirous of bringing the settlement on record in disposal of this Petition. Therefore, the parties are given liberty to mention the matter with extreme urgency before the Bench having roster under Section 37 of the Act, so that the settlement can be taken on record and the matter could be brought to an end expeditiously.

3. The parties are given liberty to mention the matter before the Learned Division Bench, so that they could clarify the position. The order impugned, being an order passed by me, it would be only inappropriate for me to take cognisance of the matter in a proceeding which is an Appeal against my own order.
