When this suit is called out for hearing, the plaintiff in person has appeared.

2. A report of the Committee of the Registrars is on record, which states that in the opinion of the Committee, the plaintiff cannot be granted permission to appear in person before this Court.

3. Despite the aforesaid opinion of the Committee, the plaintiff insists on arguing the matter in person.

4. While this Court believes that the opinion of the Committee of the Registrars may not be binding on this Court, it is found that serious questions regarding the very maintainability of the suit arise, which in the opinion of this Court, the plaintiff appearing in person, would not be able to answer.

5. A suggestion was given to the plaintiff that an advocate from the panel maintained by the Legal Services Authority can be appointed to assist her. She was not positively inclined towards the same. But, this Court is of the opinion that the plaintiff needs to consider the said opinion expressed by this Court and by the next date of hearing, come

back with her response to the same.

6. This Court is of the opinion that such matters, which necessarily involve emotional trauma allegedly suffered by the plaintiff, arguing in person, would lead to unnecessary waste of time of the Court, which can be avoided by appointment of an advocate from the panel maintained by the Legal Services Authority.
