- 1.** Not on Board. Mentioned by way of filing praecipe dated 08.05.2026. Perused the praecipe.
- 2.** Heard Mr. Zaidy, learned Advocate for Petitioners.
- 3.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Khatija Fazal Dohadwala. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No.4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No.6 of the Petition. I have perused the same.
- 4.** Consent affidavits dated 28.02.2026 of Farida Mustansir Haji and Fatema Shabbir Koita, the legal heirs are filed on record and e-



filed.

**5.** In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

*“a) That this Hon’ble Court be pleased to grant the Heirship Certificate, certifying that the Petitioners along with Farida Mustansir Haji and Fatema Shabbir Koita, as stated in paragraph no. 4 above, are the only legal heirs and representatives, to be declared as the legal heirs and representatives of the deceased Late Khatija Fazal Dohadwala, under the provisions of the Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827;”*

**6.** Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

**7.** Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

**8.** Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
