1 Interim Application No.7080/2026 seek restoration of Writ Petition (L) No.18603/2003, which was dismissed for non removal of office objections by the Prothonotary and Senior Master on 01/04/2025.

2 Heard the learned counsel for the Applicant and perused the Application as well as the order dated 01/04/2025, which dismissed the Writ Petition.



On hearing the learned counsel for the Applicant, we are satisfied about the bonafides that are shown for seeking restoration of the Writ Petition while condoning the delay. The Application has set out the circumstances as to why the dismissal of the Writ Petition was not noted and it is pleaded that from the date of knowledge, the application is filed within 35 days, but from the date of dismissal of the Writ Petition, there is delay of 263 days.

3 Since we are satisfied with the bonafides of the reasons that are set out for restoration of the Writ Petition, WP(L) No.18603/2023 is restored to its file by setting aside the order dated 01/04/2025 passed by the Prothonotary and Senior Master. Interim Application is allowed in the abovesaid terms.

We permit the office objections, if any, to be removed within a period of two weeks from today.

4 The petition is directed to be listed for consideration on 01/07/2026.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is at liberty to serve the Respondents, by private mode of service.
