1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if relief in terms of prayer clause (b) is considered for the present.

2. Our attention is invited to the representation dated 29th January 2024 addressed to the respondent No.2. Ms. Jagtap, the learned counsel appearing for MHADA submitted that so far as flat No.7 is concerned, the respondent No.2 has already decided the representation made which is similar in nature to the one made by the petitioner in respect of flat No.8. It is then pointed out that insofar as flat No.7 is concerned, representation was made by Ms.



Rekha Kanakia who is also one of the petitioner in this petition pertaining to flat No.8.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that sofar as Ms. Rekha Kanakia is concerned, she is the holder of flat No.7 as well as flat No.8.

4. In such view of the matter as representation in respect of flat No.7 has already been decided, there should be no difficulty in directing the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 29th January 2024, 24th December 2025 and 10th February 2026 mentioned in prayer clause (b) as expeditiously as possible and in any event within four weeks from 17th April 2026.

5. The petitioner to appear before respondent No.2 on 17th April 2026 at 11.00 a.m. along with copy of this order.

6. All contentions are kept open. The Writ Petition is disposed of.
