1) Mr. Kulkarni, the learned counsel submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of the Respondents. He seeks and is granted time of two weeks to file affidavit-in-reply.

2) The learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner submits that under the loan Agreement, substantial receivables by Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 from Respondent No. 4 are supposed to be used for repayment of the loan. He submits that Respondent No. 4 has issued

cheques dated 4 April 2026 to Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and he expresses an apprehension that Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 are likely to siphon off the amounts covered by the said four cheques. Accordingly, by way of ad-interim measures, it is directed that in the event the four cheques issued by the Respondent No. 4 are encashed by Respondent Nos. 1 to 3, they shall not deal with the amount of the cheques till the next date of hearing.
