1. The Interim Application seeks the following relief:

"a) That this Hon'ble Court be kind to allow the Applicant to travel to USA for a period from 25/04/2026 to 15/06/2026 and to Toronto, Canada from 15/06/2026 to 15/07/2026 on such terms and conditions as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper;"

2. Since the Application was found wanting in respect of any necessary details, the Applicant was granted liberty to file an additional affidavit in support of the Interim Application. A perusal of the said affidavit which has

been filed today is also bereft of the requisite information that would be required to consider the said application and grant the Applicant permission to travel.

3. Mr. Pandit, learned counsel for the Petitioner, has correctly pointed out that the Applicant would be required to show/disclose the following details:

- a. Complete details of the Applicant's travel itinerary to United States of America and Canada;
- b. The copies of the Applicant's tickets for the onward and return journeys;
- c. Particulars of the address where the Applicant would be staying during his travel and the contact details that would be actively used by him during his travel;
- d. Particulars of the source of income used for the expenses of the Applicant's travel;
- e. The disclosure of the Applicant's assets i.e., immovable and movable property; and
- f. An undertaking to abide by the travel itinerary and not to apply for renewal or extension of any orders that shall be passed by this Hon'ble Court until the Applicant returns to India.

4. In the event, the Applicant is desirous of travelling, then the said details would have to be set out clearly. In the absence thereof, I am not inclined to allow the application in the manner that has been presented.
