1. This Judge's Order seeks permission of this Court, to withdraw the monies deposited in favour of the minor, as he has turned major on 9th June, 2025.
2. When the matter is called out, Ms. Agicha, learned Counsel appears for the Petitioner as well as the Applicant and submits that earlier pursuant to the order dated 12th January, 2015 read with order dated 21st January, 2015, this Court had given direction with respect to the Applicant's share of Rs. 1,05,00,000/- to be deposited with the Accounts Officer of this Court and which was also invested. It is submitted that two Fixed Deposits were created and in respect of the two Fixed Deposits the amounts now lying are Rs. 93,38,962/- and Rs. 98,10,734/- respectively.



3. That the monies were to be paid to the Applicant upon attaining majority. Ms. Agicha submits that the Applicant has turned major on 9th June, 2025 and that, therefore, this Court may direct the Accounts Officer to make payment of the amounts lying in his name, which is also confirmed by the certificate of balance at page 17.

4. Having heard the learned Counsel and having considered the submissions, the Accounts Officer is directed to make payments of the two Fixed Deposits lying in this Court as per certificate of balance at page 17 to the Applicant within a period of two weeks.
