P.C.:-

1) By the present Interim Application, the Applicant seeks withdrawal of the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- deposited with the Prothonotary and Senior Master of this Court, along with the interest accrued thereon.

2) Mr. Piyush Kranti, learned advocate appearing for the Applicant



states that the Applicant who was accused No. 2 in Complaint No. 3 of 2013 had sought permission of this Court to travel abroad in furtherance of potential employment opportunities. This Court by order dated 24th August 2022 granted permission to the Applicant/Orig. Accused No.2 to travel abroad, subject to furnishing a Personal Bond and surety and/or cash security in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and certain other conditions.

3) It is submitted by Mr. Kranti that thereafter the Applicant/Orig. Accused No. 2 has been acquitted by the judgment and order dated 1st October 2025 passed by learned Single Judge in Complaint No. 3 of 2023 in Company Petition No. 6280 of 2008. In view of this, the present Interim Application is filed seeking liberty to withdraw Rs. 1,00,000/- by the Applicant/Orig. Accused No.2 deposited with the Prothonotary and Senior Master, Bombay High Court, alongwith interest accrued.

4) Learned counsel appearing for the Complainant-Official Liquidator has no objection to the same.

5) Accordingly, the Interim Application is allowed in terms of prayer clauses (a) and (b), which read as under :

(a) This Hon'ble Court may be pleased to grant liberty to the Applicant/Orig. Accused No.2 to withdraw the amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- [Rupees One Lakh Only] deposited with the Prothonotary and Senior Master, Bombay High Court, alongwith interest accrued thereon, if any;



(b) that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the Prothonotary and Senior Master, Hon'ble Bombay High Court, to release the amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- [Rupees One Lakh Only] deposited by the Applicant/Orig. Accused No. 2, along with interest accrued thereon, if any, in favour of the Applicant/Orig. Accused No.2, in terms of prayer clause (a) above.

6) The Interim Application is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
