- 1) This is an Application under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (**the Arbitration Act**) seeking appointment of Arbitrator for adjudication of disputes and differences between the parties arising out of the concerned Purchase Orders.
- 2) I have heard Mr. Ingale, the learned counsel appearing for the Applicant and Mr. Gaikwad, the learned counsel appearing for the Respondent.
- 3) Perusal of the Purchase Orders indicates presence of arbitration agreement between the parties. Seat of the arbitration is at Pune. Mr.



Gaikwad fairly does not dispute existence of arbitration agreement between the parties. Both the learned counsel jointly request for appointment of a sole Arbitrator for conduct of arbitral proceedings at Pune.

4) In view of the consensus prevailing between the parties, I proceed to pass the following order:-

(A) Mr. Justice Shrikant Kulkarni, former Judge of this Court is appointed as sole Arbitrator to adjudicate upon the disputes and differences between the parties arising out of concerned Purchase Orders. The contact details of the Arbitrator are as under:-

(B) A copy of this order be communicated to the learned sole Arbitrator by the Advocates for the Applicant within a period of one week from the date of uploading of this order. The Applicant shall provide the contact and communication particulars of the parties to the Arbitral Tribunal alongwith a copy of this order.

(C) The learned sole Arbitrator is requested to forward the statutory Statement of Disclosure under Section 11(8) read with Section 12(1) of the Act to the parties within a period of 2 weeks from receipt of a copy of this order.



(D) The parties shall appear before the learned sole Arbitrator on such date and at such place as indicated by him, to obtain appropriate direction with regard to conduct of the arbitration including fixing a schedule for pleadings, examination of witnesses, if any, schedule of hearings etc.

(E) The fees of the sole Arbitrator shall be as prescribed under the Bombay High Court (Fee Payable to Arbitrators) Rules, 2018 and the arbitral costs and fees of the Arbitrator shall be borne by the parties in equal portion and shall be subject to the final Award that may be passed by the Tribunal.

5) All issues on merits are expressly kept open to be agitated before the Arbitral Tribunal appointed as above.

6) With the above directions, the Application is **disposed of**.
