1. Not on Board mentioned by way of filling a praecipe dated 09.04.2026, perused the praecipe.

2. Heard Mr. Rane, learned Advocate for Petitioner.

3. Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioners for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Prakash Ramchandra Yadwadkar. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No.4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No.8 of the Petition. I have perused the same.

4. Consent Affidavits dated 07.04.2026 of (1)Renuka Parikshit Vaidya and (2)Saumitra Prakash Yadwadkar, the legal heirs are filed on record and appended at page Nos.27 to 31 of Petition.



5. In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

"a' That Legal Heirship Certificate in the form of Appendix OF THE Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 be granted to the Petitioner i.e. (1)Sandhya Prakash Yadwadkar and legal heirs i.e. (2)Renuka Parikshit Vaidya and (3)Saumitra Prakash Yadwadkar declaring that legal heirs of Deceased Late Prakash Ramchandra Yadwadkar and to entitle estate of the deceased which is more particularly mentioned in the Schedule -I herein at Exhibit "D" to the present petition."

6. Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.
7. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.
8. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
9. Praecipe is disposed.
