Pursuant to the earlier orders of this Court, today when the matter is called out, Mr. Carlos, learned Counsel, appearing for the Respondent states that order dated 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024 had been complied with and the same has been recorded in the order dated 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2024 as the same has been complied with in accordance with order dated 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2024 as the demand draft of Rs.2,27,50,000/- have been deposited before the Prothonotary & Senior Master.

2. Mr. Narula, learned Counsel for the Contempt Petitioner however submits that orders dated 12<sup>th</sup> March 2013 and 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2013 are yet to be complied with and to that extent the contempt still subsists. Mr. Narula has taken this Court to paragraph 3 of the order dated 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2013 and submits that the Defendant No.4 who is the licensee in the suit premises was required to deposit 50% of the license fees from August 2013 and also pay Religare Finvest Ltd., the remainder 50%. That 50% license fees is yet pending.

3. Mr. Carlos, learned Counsel, appearing for the Defendant No.2 submits that Religare Finvest Ltd. has been paid of. However, as regards payment of 50% license fees, he would need to take instructions and seeks some time to file further Affidavit in the matter.

4. Let further Affidavit on this aspect be filed within a period of two weeks with copy to the others. Rejoinder be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter, with copy to the others.
5. List on **9<sup>th</sup> July 2025**.
6. Let office objections to the Interim Applications be removed and registered number be obtained within a period of two weeks, failing which the Interim Applications to stand dismissed without further reference to the Court.
