ORDER :

1. These are the Petitions filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking an extension of mandate of the Learned Arbitral Tribunal which is expired on **May 8, 2026**.

2. Today, when the matter is called out, Learned Advocate for the Respondent seeks times to take instructions in considering the matter. However, as rightly pointed out by the Learned Advocate for the Petitioner,
