2. On 5th May, 2026, the following order was passed:-

“1. This Leave Petition seeks leave under Clause XII of the Letters Patent.

2. When the matter is called out, Mr. Joshi, learned Counsel appears for the Petitioner and submits that in the Suit proposed to be filed seeking *inter alia* a declaration that the termination notice dated 26th March, 2025 is legal, valid and binding upon the Defendants, although the material part of cause of action has arisen within the jurisdiction of this Court, however, since the Defendants No. 1 to 3 have their place of business outside the jurisdiction of this Court, with leave granted by this Court under Clause XII of the Letters Patent, this Court would have jurisdiction to entertain, try and dispose of the Suit.

3. Mr. Joshi draws this Court’s attention to paragraph 4 of the Leave Petition and paragraph 12 of the Plaint in the proposed Suit in support of his contentions.

4. However, it is observed that there is no specific averment in the Complaint with respect to the obtention of leave under Clause XII of the Letters Patent.

5. Mr. Joshi, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner seeks some time to amend the Complaint.

6. At his request, list on **8th May, 2026.**”

3. It does not appear that the Complaint has been amended.

4. Accordingly, list on **22nd June, 2026.**
