1. When the matter is called out, Ms. Gogri, learned Counsel appears for the Applicant and submits that service of the Interim Application as well as the Execution Application has already been effected and despite that there have been no payments under the award dated 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 and that this Court may grant disclosures in terms of prayer Clauses (b) and (d).

2. Having heard the learned Counsel and having considered the submissions, this Court is of the view that relief in terms of prayer Clauses (b) and (d) be granted, which read thus:-

“(b) That the Respondent above named be required by an order of this Hon’ble Court to file his Affidavit stating particulars of his properties etc., as provided under Order 21 Rule 41 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

(d) That the Respondent be directed to disclose their means on affidavit for satisfying the decree of the Applicant under execution as per Section 51 of the Code of Civil Procedure.”

3. Let affidavit of disclosure on oath in terms of prayer Clauses (b) and (d) be filed by the Respondents within a period of four weeks.
4. Let a copy of this order be served upon the Respondents and an appropriate affidavit of service be filed by the next date.
5. List on **23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2026**.
