- 3.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Ganpat Rama Bandre alias Ganpat Bandre alias Ganpat Ramchandra Bandre. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 7 of the Petition. I have perused the same.



4. Consent affidavit dated 29.04.2026 of Vidya Rajendra Boble nee Vidya Ganpat Bandre, the legal heir is filed on record and appended at page No. 29 of Petition.

5. In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

"a. This Hon'ble Court be pleased to issue a Legal Heirship Certificate to the petitioner under the provisions of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827, certifying that the 1) Vinayak Ganpat Bandre (son) and 2) Vidya Rajendra Boble nee Vidya Ganpat Bandre (daughter) are the only surviving Class – I Legal Heirs of the Deceased. i.e. Ganpat Rama Bandre alias Ganpat Bandre alias Ganpat Ramchandra Bandre."

6. Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

7. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

8. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
