2. Heard Mr. Munshi, learned Senior Advocate for Petitioner.
3. Office is directed to number the Petition forthwith. Objection taken in the requisition dated 29.04.2026 and 08.04.2026 stands dispensed with. The name of the deceased is Jamnadas Velji Thakker. Rashmikant & Partners, having their office at Kalpataru Heritage, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, 127, M.G.Road, Fort, Mumbai 400 001 in compliance with Rule 397 of the Rules.
