1. This is a Petition under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking an extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal, which expired on April 30, 2026.

2. Today, when the matter is called out, Learned Counsel for the parties jointly request for an extension of mandate by a period of three months, bearing in mind the stage at which the arbitral proceedings are placed.



3. In these circumstances, taking into account the stage at which the Arbitral proceedings are placed and since only the passing of the Arbitral Award is pending, this Petition is ***finally disposed of*** extending the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period of ***three*** months, i.e. until ***August 31, 2026***.
