- 1.** Not on Board. Mentioned by way of filing praecipe dated 06.05.2026. Perused the praecipe.
- 2.** Heard Mrs. Nair, learned Advocate for Petitioner.
- 3.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Mohan Chnadra Taradutt Bhakt. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 7 of the Petition. I have perused the same.
- 4.** Joint consent affidavit dated 06.04.2026, of Chanda Sachin Gupte and Surajkumar Mohan Bhakt the legal heirs are filed on record



and appended at page No. 28 of Petition and Consent Affidavits dated 25.04.2026 and 17.04.2026 of Poonam B. Kapadia and Banita Mohit Hariya, the legal heirs are filed on record and appended at page Nos. 33 and 39 of Petition.

**5.** In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

*"(a) That a Legal Heirship Certificate Certifying that the Petitioner along with the heirs mentioned in Para No. 4 above viz. (i) Anandi Mohan Bhakt (wife-widow of deceased); (ii) Chanda Sachin Gupte (daughter of the deceased), (iii) Poonam B. Kapadia (daughter of deceased), (iv) Surajkumar Mohan Bhakt (son of deceased), (v) Banita Mohit Hariya (daughter of deceased) being the only heirs and legal representative of the said deceased under the Provision of Bombay Regulation Act, VIII of 1827."*

**6.** Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

**7.** Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

**8.** Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
