- 1.** Not on Board. Mentioned by way of filing praecipe dated 06.05.2026. Perused the praecipe.
- 2.** Heard Mrs. Nair, learned Advocate for Petitioner.
- 3.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Vishanlal Bhikaram Mistry @ Vishanlal Bhikharam Mistry. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 6 of the Petition. I have perused the same.
- 4.** Joint consent affidavit dated 27.04.2026 of Keshav Suthar and Naveen Suthar, the legal heirs are filed on record and appended at



page No.33 of Petition and Consent Affidavits dated 04.05.2026 of Rekha Anupkumar Suthar and Laxmi Narayan Vishanlal Mistry, the legal heirs are filed on record and appended at page Nos. 25 and 29 of Petition.

**5.** In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

*"(a) That a Legal Heirship Certificate Certifying that the Petitioner along with the heirs mentioned in Para No. 4 above viz. (i) Shakuntala Vishanlal Mistry @ Shakuntala Devi (wife -widow of the deceased), (ii) Rekha Anupkumar Suthar (daughter of the deceased), (iii) Laxmi Narayan Vishanlal Mistry (son of the deceased), (iv) Keshav Suthar (grandson of the deceased); and (v) Naveen Suthar (grandson of the deceased) being the only heirs and legal representative of the said deceased under the Provision of Bombay Regulation Act, VIII of 1827."*

**6.** Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

**7.** Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

**8.** Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
