**1.** Not on Board. Mentioned by way of filing praecipe dated 07.05.2026. Perused the praecipe.

**2.** Heard Ms. Patil, learned Advocate for Petitioner.

**3.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Ramesh Vanmalidas Shah. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No.4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No.7 of the Petition. I have perused the same.

**4.** Consent affidavit dated 30.04.2026 of Hemlata Ramesh Shah and Avni Ankit Shah, the legal heirs are filed on record and appended



at page Nos.28 and 32 of Petition.

**5.** In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

*“a. This Hon’ble Court be pleased to issue a Legal Heirship Certificate to the Petitioner under the provision of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827, certifying that 1) Hemlata Ramesh Shah (widow), 2) Chintan Ramesh shah (son) and 3) Avni Ankit Shah (daughter) are the only surviving Class – I legal heirs and legal representatives of the abovenamed deceased i.e., Ramesh Vanmalidas Shah.”*

**6.** Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

**7.** Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

**8.** Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
