- 2.** Heard Ms. Thapa, learned Advocate for Petitioners.
- 3.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Anaji Khemaji Taraye. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No.5 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 8 of the Petition. I have perused the same.
- 4.** Consent affidavits dated 05.05.2026 of Sayali Ramesh Taraye and Sayali Ramesh Taraye in capacity as natural guardian of minor son

5. In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which reads thus:-

*“a) This Hon’ble Court be pleaded to issue a Legal Heirship Certificate thereby certifying the Petitioners i.e. VANASHREE DINESH BHOMBAD nee VANDANA ANAJI TARAYE and SAIEE PRITAM SANGARE nee VIJAYA ANAJI TARAYE alongwith other legal heirs viz. SAYALI RAMESH TARAYE and AAYUSH RAMESH TARAYE as legal heir and representative of the said deceased (Late) ANAJI KHEMAJI TARAYE, under the provisions of the Bombay Regulation Act, VIII of 1827.”*

6. Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

7. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

8. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
