1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. This is an application for condonation of delay in seeking restoration of the Petition which came to be dismissed by an order dated 11 March 2026 for non-removal of office objections and to also restore the Writ Petition (L) No.11757 of 2024 and the order dated 8 April 2024 passed by this Court.
3. Learned Counsel for the Applicants, on instructions, submits that the Applicants will remove office objections within a period of two weeks.
4. For the reasons assigned in the application and to advance the cause of substantive justice, the delay in preferring the application for restoration of the petition deserves to be condoned and the order dismissing the petition for non-removal of office objections under the provisions of Rule 986 of the



Original Side Rules, deserves to be set aside and the petition restored to file.

5. The Interim Application stands allowed.
6. Writ Petition (L) No.11757 of 2024 stands restored to file, subject to the Petitioners removing office objections within a period of two weeks from today.
7. In the event, office objections are not removed within a period of two weeks, this order shall stand recalled and WP(L) No.11757 of 2024 shall stand dismissed without reference to the court.
8. As this court has passed an order dated 8 April 2024 after recording reasons, the said order also stands restored.
9. In the event, office objections are removed, list the Petition on 7 July 2026.
