By this writ petition, the petitioner-Firm seeks the following reliefs:-

- a. Be pleased to issue a writ of certiorari or a writ in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction calling for the records and papers pertaining to the impugned letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2025 issued by respondent no.3 and after perusing the same, be pleased to quash and set it aside;*
- b. This Hon'ble Court be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, directing the respondent nos.1 to 3 to strictly enforce the conflict-of-interest clause in section 6, clause 55 and the profitability clause in section 6 clause F of the subject Tender dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025 read with Corrigendum-III dated 1<sup>st</sup> July 2025 to consequently disqualify respondent nos.5 to 12 from the bidding*



*process and to reopen the tendering process to invite fresh bids under the subject Tender;*

- c. Pending the hearing and final disposal of the present petition, this Hon'ble Court be pleased to stay the effect, implementation and operation of the impugned letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2025;*
- d. Pending the hearing and final disposal of the present petition, this Hon'ble Court be pleased to restrain respondent nos.1 to 4, their servants, officers, agents and/or assigns from in any manner (directly and/or indirectly) from proceeding with the subject tender viz. E-Tender for Collection and Transportation of Municipal Solid Waste in Wards of Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation to Transfer Stations and Final Disposal Sites, in any manner whatsoever, including with opening of Packet C;*
- e. Ad-interim relief in terms of prayers (c) and (d) above;*
- f. For costs of this Petition be provided for; and*
- g. For such further and other reliefs as the nature and circumstances of the case may require be granted.”*

2. Mr. Harsh Sheth, on instructions, seeks permission to withdraw this writ petition in view of the e-mail communication dated 24<sup>th</sup> January 2026 received from the petitioner-Firm stating that the petitioner-Firm has collectively taken a decision to withdraw this writ petition. 3. In view of the above, Writ Petition (Lodging) No.30433 of 2025 is dismissed as withdrawn.
