PER COURT :

1. Heard the learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. By the present petition, the petitioners are assailing the order dated 30.09.2016 passed by respondent no.4- Authorized Officer/Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Biloli, Ta. & Dist. Nanded and the certificate dated 14.12.2016 issued by respondent no.3-District Deputy Registrar, Nanded. The petitioners are also assailing the order dated 05.01.2017 passed by respondent no.2-Divisional Joint Registrar, Latur, whereby the appeal filed by the petitioners came to be dismissed.
3. The petitioners have an alternate and equally efficacious remedy to challenge the impugned orders by filing a revision under Section 154 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act, 1960.
4. In view of the above, the Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to



the petitioners to challenge the impugned orders by filing a revision under Section 154 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act.

5. Needless to mention, the time spent in prosecuting the present petition shall be taken into consideration by the revisional authority while deciding an application of condonation of delay, if the revision is filed within a period of two months from today.

6. If such revision is filed within the aforesaid period, the revisional authority shall decide the same on its own merits, as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of six months thereafter.

7. The interim order passed by this Court shall continue to operate till the revisional authority decides the matter.
