PER COURT :

1. The learned counsel Mr. Nagarjoge for the petitioner would submit that pursuant to the order dated 23.03.2026, petitioner has deposited the amount of Rs. 50,000/- to show his bonafides. The copy of the cheque is placed on record and marked as "X" for identification.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order is passed ex-parte and in absence of the petitioner. The petitioner is ready for one time settlement with the respondents. So taking into consideration that the petitioner has shown his bonafides to deposit the amount of Rs. 1.5 Lakhs pursuant to the order dated 06.03.2026, issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 22.04.2026.

3. The petitioner shall serve respondent through private mode of service in addition to the regular mode of service and submit the acknowledgment before this Court on next date of hearing.

4. Till then, the interim order in terms of prayer Clause (B) is granted, which reads as under :

“B) Pending hearing hearing and final disposal of the present Writ Petition, the execution, implementation and operation of the impugned judgment and order dated 23.06.2023 (Exhibit- “C”), passed by the learned JMFC, Dharur, District Beed in Criminal Misc. Application No. 164/2021 as condirmed by the learned Additional Sessions Court Kaij on 06.11.2026 (Exhibit- “E”) in Criminal Revision Application No. 60/2023 may kindly be stayed.”
