**PER COURT :-**

1. A short question arises for consideration of this Court is whether the petitioner who claims to have accepted the amount as quantified by respondent No.4 in the demand notice, the respondents could have rejected the declaration filed by the petitioner under the provisions of 'Sabka Vishwas Scheme' or not.

2. Mr. Talhar, learned ASGI waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.1 to 3.

3. Issue notice upon respondent No.4, returnable on 25.04.2022. *Humdast* is permitted.

4. In addition to Court notice, petitioner is permitted to serve respondent No.4 by private notice. Affidavit-in-reply, if any, shall be filed within a period of two (2) weeks by respondent No.4 from the date of service of the papers and proceedings with a copy to be served upon the petitioner's advocate simultaneously. Rejoinder, if any, shall be filed within a period of one (1) week, thereafter.
