1. Heard.

2. The Petitioner is challenging the order passed by the Revisional Court thereby allowing the Revision filed by the Respondent/Wife challenging the order passed by the learned J.M.F.C., rejecting the 125 Cr.PC. application filed by the Respondent/Wife.

3. The learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that there are three orders operating against the present Petitioner, directing him to pay maintenance to the Respondent/Wife and children. The Revisional Court was aware of the earlier two orders passed by the Civil Court. By order dated 07.07.2018 in RCS No. 134/2017, the Petitioner was directed to pay an amount of Rs. 10,000/- towards maintenance of the Respondent/Wife and children. Subsequently,

another order of the same Court directed the Petitioner to pay Rs. 15,000/- towards their maintenance, along with an additional Rs. 3,000/- towards alternate accommodation.

4. The Thus taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions and also considering the fact that the Petitioner is shown his bona fides by depositing an amount of Rs. 8,00,000/- in pursuance to the order dated 09.03.2026, issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 15.04.2026.

5. In the meanwhile, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 'C' which are as under :

“C. Grant stay to the impugned judgment and order dated 11.12.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangamner in Criminal Appeal No. 09/2022 pending hearing and final disposal of the present Criminal Writ Petition.”

6. The Respondent/Wife is at liberty to make an application for withdrawal of the amount deposited by the Petitioner.
