**CIVIL APPLICATION FOR DELAY**

. The applicants seek to condone delay of 4867 days in preferring the appeal.

2. The learned counsel for the acquiring body vehemently opposes the application. It is contended that there is oblique motive on the part of the applicants and they were aware of the decision but deliberately failed to file the appeal in time.

3. The averments of the application have not been traversed by the
