1. None present. The present Writ Petitions are listed for the third time for removal of objections. These matters came to be filed between the year 2023 and 2024. Initially two weeks time was granted for removing office objections. However, on failure to remove the same, further time of two weeks was extended.

2. Today also none present for removal of office objections. It appears that petitioners are not interested to proceed with these matters and thus, the registration is required to be refused. Instead of passing coercive order, one more opportunity on principle of natural justice is allowed by imposing condition. Hence, following order.

ORDER

Three weeks time is granted to remove the office objections. It is also made clear that on failure on the part of petitioners to remove the office objections within stipulated period of three weeks as stated herein, the registration of the said Writ Petitions shall stand automatically refused without any further reference to the Court of Registrar (Judicial).
