1. Heard Mr. Farooki, holding for Mr. Dushing, learned counsel for the applicants. The learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants were already granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 15.3.2025 passed by the Sessions Court before invocation of the stringent provisions of the Atrocities Act. The applicants have complied with the conditions imposed vide order dated 15.3.2025 granting anticipatory bail to the applicants in original Crime No. 29 of 2025, which was initially registered only under Section 107 r/w. 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita and further undertakes to comply with any such additional conditions, that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, the applicants may be protected.

2. Taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions and particularly, the order dated 15.3.2025, wherein, the anticipatory bail application was already allowed by the learned Additional Sessions



Judge, Court, No.3 Ahmednagar, before invocation of the stringent provisions of Atrocities Act., I am inclined to protect the applicants , till the investigation papers are seen, however, upon certain conditions.

ORDER

[I] In the event of arrest of the applicant, in connection with Crime No. 29 of 2025, registered with Tophkhanka Police Station, District Ahilyanagar, for the offences punishable under Sections 107, 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita and under Sections 3(2)(v), 3(1)(r) of the SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, and under Section 12 of the POCSO Act, the applicant Ansh Sachin Ratnaparkhi and Archana Sachin Ratnaparkhi, be released on bail on furnishing PR Bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/-, each with one or more sureties in the like amount, on the following conditions :-

[i] The applicants shall attend the concerned police station and report to the Investigating Officer on every Sunday between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. until further orders and shall cooperate with the investigation.

[ii] The applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.

[iii] The applicant shall submit his Aadhar and Pan card to the Investigating Officer alongwith mobile numbers and addresses of two of his near relatives.

[iv] Stand over to 16th June, 2026.
