PER COURT :

1. Learned Advocate for the Respondent through Video Conferencing submitted that he is appearing on behalf of the Respondent and will file Vakilpatra and reply to the Application by 10.06.2026.
2. No further time will be granted.
3. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to continue the stay of the proceedings pending before the learned Civil Judge Senior Division, Niphad, District Nashik, as I do not see any necessity to continue the stay of the proceedings unnecessarily, particularly when the facility of video conferencing is available to the parties.
4. It is further noted that, in proceedings of the present nature, personal appearance of the parties on each and every date is not

mandatory unless specifically directed by the learned Trial Court. The learned Advocates for the respective parties may effectively prosecute the matter even in the parties' absence.

5. In such circumstances, I am not inclined to continue the stay of the proceedings pending before the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Niphad, District Nashik. In view of the above, **the Interim relief granted by this Court on 17.03.2026, is hereby vacated.**

6. Needless to clarify that, in the event the Applicant prefers an application seeking permission to participate in the proceedings through video conferencing before the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Niphad, District Nashik, the learned Court shall consider such application on its own merits positively.

7. Inform the concerned Court accordingly.

8. Stand over to **16.06.2026.**
