**P.C. :-**

1. Heard Mr. Jadhavar, learned counsel for the applicants. Mr. Jadhavar would submits that the applicants are falsely implicated in the present crime only with an intention to implicate the entire Ghule family.

2. The learned counsel for applicants submits that the applicants have withdrawn the earlier bail application bearing ABA No.1532 of 2025, in view of the fact that the charge sheet was filed and there is no adjudication on merits.

3. The other co-accused are already released on anticipatory bail vide order dated 24.9.2025 passed by this Court in ABA No. 1526 of 2025. The counter FIR bearing Crime No. 406 of 2025, the accused Pandharinath, Deepak, Bajrang, Ashok, Parsuram, Uddhav, Vithabai and Sarita Ghule are already released on anticipatory bail. Some of the accused – Ganesh, Siddheshwar , Ravi, Gaurav Gajanan, Ashok and Pandurang are released in Crime No. 408 of 2025. Except for the aforesaid offences, the applicants are not having any criminal

antecedents and are ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, the applicants may be protected.

2. Thus, taking into consideration aforesaid submissions and particularly, the order passed by this Court granting anticipatory bail to accused Pandharinath, Deepak, Bajarang, Ashok, Parshram, Uddhav, Vithabai and Savita vide order dated 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 in A.B.A. No.1526 of 2025, I am inclined to protect the applicants. Hence, the following order :-

#### O R D E R

[I] In the event of arrest of the applicants in connection with Crime No. 0406 of 2025, registered with Selu Police Station, District. Parbhani, for the offences punishable U/Sec. 09, 115-2, 118-1, 118-2, 189-2, 189-4, 190, 91-2, 191-3, 351-2, 351-3, 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and U/Sec. 4/25 of e Arms Act and U/Sec.135 of the aharashtra Police Act the applicants [I] Gajanan Ashok Ghule [II] Pandurang Dattu Ghule and [III] Ankush Dhondiba Ghule, be released on bail on furnishing PR Bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- each, with one or more sureties in the like amount, on the following conditions :-

[i] The applicants shall attend the concerned police station and report to the Investigating Officer on every Sunday starting from 10th May, 2026, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. until further orders and shall cooperate with the investigation.

[ii] The applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.

[iii] The applicants shall submit their, Aadhar card and

Pan card to the Investigating Officer alongwith mobile numbers and addresses of two of his near relatives.
