. Present petition contends that without adhering to the procedure of law in respect of acquisition the respondent authorities are expanding or upgrading the road.

2 Heard learned Advocate for petitioners. Learned AGP waives notice for respondents/State and learned Advocate Mr. R.B. Bagul waives notice for respondent Nos.1, 5 and 12.

3           Except 7/12 extracts and the representation to respondent No.4  
there is nothing on record to show that the lands of petitioners are affected.  
Now, the petitioners are expecting that this Court should issue the Writ of  
Mandamus for the measurement of road also, which, in fact, they can get it  
done by approaching the appropriate authority. When there is absolutely no  
document, which would directly show that the lands or portion of the lands  
of the petitioners would be affected; when this question was asked, the  
learned Advocate seeks accommodation.

4           Stand over to **17.06.2026**.

5           In the meantime, the petitioners would be at liberty to produce  
the necessary documents on record along with additional affidavit.
