1. None present. The above numbered batch of Writ Petitions/PIL came to be listed for the third time on the board of Registrar (Judicial). The Writ Petitions from Sr. No. 102 to 106 came to be filed in the year 2021. In these matters initially three weeks and subsequently two weeks time was granted to remove the

office objections. However, no steps have been taken to remove the same. Five weeks time is sufficient to remove the office objections.

2. Furthermore, the matters at Sr. No. 107 to 203 came to be filed in the year 2022. From the record, it appears that objections were notified therein despite which no steps have been taken to remove the same. It is necessary to state here that these matters were listed on the board of Registrar (Judicial) for the first time wherein two weeks time was granted for the purpose of removing office objections. Subsequently, having not taken any steps, the matters were again listed for the second time and even at this stage, no steps were taken to remove the objections. Eventually, in the interest of natural justice, one more week was granted for the said purpose. In totality, three weeks time was granted till today. Three weeks time is sufficient time to remove the office objections, thus, the petitioners appear to be not keen to remove the office objections and proceed with these matters.

3. In view of above circumstances, fitness of things requires refusal of registration instead of keeping these matters pending

without any steps been taken. However, at the same time, instead of passing any stringent order outrightly, I am of the considered view that in the interest of natural justice, one more opportunity needs to be granted, which opportunity cannot be without any condition and I pass the following order.

ORDER

Two more weeks time is granted to remove the office objections. It is also made clear that on the failure on the part of petitioners to remove the office objections within stipulated period of two weeks as stated herein, the registration of the said writ petitions/PIL shall stand automatically refused without any further reference to the Court of Registrar (Judicial).
