1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned APP for respondent Nos. 1 to 5 – State.
2. Taking into consideration the fact that the last offence registered against the present petitioner is Crime No. 15 of 2024 registered on 22.02.2024 and there appears to be absence of a live link between the last alleged criminal activity of the petitioner and the impugned order of externment dated 26.12.2025, I am inclined to pass the following order :-

ORDER

A) Admit.

B) There shall be interim relief in terms of prayer clause 'D', which reads as under :-

*“D] Pending hearing and final disposal of this Criminal Writ Petition, The impugned order passed by the Respondent No. 2 on dated 26.12.2025 in file No. 2024/Gr.Sha. / M.PA.1951 (56) (1) (B) Haddapar /Pra.6025/2024 Sindakhed / CR- dated 26/12/2025 in file No. 2024 / Gr.Sha. / M.P.A.1951 (56) (1) (B) Haddapar / Pra.6025 / 2024 Sindakhed / CR-, thereby externing the petitioner for nine month from the territorial limits of Nanded, Hingoli and Yavatmal district and the impugned order passed by Respondent No. 1 on dated 27.03.2026 bearing outward No. 2026 / GAD/Desk-1/pol-1/ exterment / CR-07 has been confirmed, may kindly be stayed.”*
