2. Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 7.5.2026.
Learned AGP waives notice for all the respondents.
3. Mr. Kale h/f Mr. Salunke, learned advocate appearing for petitioner points out that petitioner was allotted sand spot after following due process of law. The petitioner has deposited amount of auction and accordingly he was excavating the land. At this stage, impugned order is passed by the learned S.D.O., Beed directing petitioner to stop excavation. Petitioner was neither served with show cause notice prior to passing of such order nor he was given any opportunity of hearing. Even there is no report from the Tahsildar. According to Mr. Kale the action against petitioner is politically motivated. In that view of matter, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause "C" till the returnable date.
