ORDER :-

Present petition has been filed by a party-in-person seeking direction to the respondents - University to issue him the provisional result/mark-sheet of 8th Semester and 9th Semester of 'B.A., LLB' course, to enable the petitioner to meet the deadline of application for All India Bar Examination (AIBE). By way of interim relief, he prays to direct the respondents to issue provisional result/mark-sheet so as to enable to meet the deadline of application for AIBE and also prays to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents - University to conduct immediate evaluation of the papers. Other prayers have also been made.

2. Mr.Aditya Lokhande holding for Mr.S.S.Tope, learned counsel for respondent nos.1 and 2, on oral instructions, makes a statement that the papers of the petitioner in all three in numbers have been assessed by the respondents - University and in one paper (i.e. Environmental Law), out of 80 marks, the petitioner has secured 37 marks and has passed in that subject. As regards the other two subjects, his answer-sheets have been evaluated, however, he has not cleared those subjects. Learned counsel seeks accommodation to place the communication in writing as well as to file affidavit-in-reply. The petitioner-in-person disputes this factual aspect and submits that he has not been communicated by the respondents.

3. Here, it has to be noted that in view of the Schedule of AIBE, we have taken up the matter. However, in view of the statement made on behalf of respondent nos.1 and 2, we are not in a position to grant any interim relief to the petitioner. Of course, when the petitioner-in-person is disputing so also in order to give an opportunity to the respondents - University to place on record their stand, we simply adjourn the matter.

4. Place the matter for further consideration on 07.05.2026.
5. The respondents - University shall file the affidavit-in-reply on or before 05.05.2026.
