1. The applicant has approached this Court seeking permission to travel abroad by relaxing the condition imposed by this Court vide order dated 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 passed in ABA No. 1706 of 2025.
2. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant alongwith his wife and son is intending to travel to Japan and as such, permission may be granted to travel abroad by relaxing the condition imposed by this Court vide the aforesaid order. The learned counsel further submits that co-accused Moksha the real sister of the applicant has already been granted such permission earlier by order of this Court dated 9.12.2026 passed in Criminal Application NO. 4638 of 2025. The applicant has annexed herewith the travel documents alongwith Air Tickets and Visa, to substantiate his submission. The applicant further undertakes to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court



3. The learned APP and the learned Assisting Counsel strongly oppose the application, however, concede that if such application is allowed, strict conditions may be imposed if the applicant is permitted to travel abroad by relaxing the conditions.

4. After going through the application and the grounds mentioned therein, I am inclined to pass the following order :-

### **ORDER**

[a] The applicant Abhishek Rajendra Shah, is permitted to leave the country from 16.5.2026 to 27.5.2026.

[b] The applicant shall report to the concerned police station, after returning back, on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 between 11.00 to 1.00 p.m. and shall produce on record a copy of attendance in the police station, on the next date of hearing.

[c] The applicant shall furnish the details of his stay/accommodation in the country in which he intends to travel, to the Investigation Officer, before leaving India.

[d] Stand over to 22.6.2026.

[e] The application is disposed of.
