PER COURT :

1. Heard learned counsel for the Applicants.
2. Issue notice to the Respondent, returnable on 18th June 2026.
3. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant stay to the proceedings pending before the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division at Malegaon, Dist. Nashik, as I do not see any necessity to stay the proceedings unnecessarily particularly when the facility of video conferencing is available to the parties.
4. It is further noted that, in proceedings of the present nature, personal appearance of the parties on each and every date is not mandatory unless specifically directed by the learned Trial Court. The learned Advocates for the respective parties may effectively prosecute the matter even in the absence of the parties.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the prayer for stay of the proceedings before the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Malegaon, Dist. Nashik, stands rejected.

6. Needless to clarify that, in the event the Applicant prefers an application seeking permission to participate in the proceedings through video conferencing before the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Malegaon, Dist. Nashik, the learned Court shall consider such application on its own merits positively.
