1. Heard Mr. Altamash Shaikh, h/f. Mr. Shaikh Parvez Ahmed, the learned counsel for the applicant.
2. Notice returnable on 22nd June, 2026.
3. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the matter is amicably settled between the complainant and the applicant. There are counter FIR bearing No. 22 of 2026 filed by the applicant Shaikh Adil Raunak against the complainant Mohd. Ikram Khan, who is also an accused. The co-accused have already been protected vide order dated 7.3.2026 passed in A.B.A. No. 408 of 2026. The applicant is not having any criminal antecedents and is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, the applicant may be protected.

2. Taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions, particularly, the order dated 7.3.2026 protecting the other co-accused Mohd. Hanif Mohd. Aref, Shahnaz Fatima and Akhil Shaikh, on the ground that there is already settlement between the parties, I am inclined to protect the applicants until further orders. Hence, the following order.

ORDER

[I] In the event of arrest of the applicant, in connection with Crime No. 20 of 2026 registered with Beed city Police Station, District Beed, for the offence under Sections 109-1, 118-2, 118-1, 115-1, 352, 189-2, 189-4, 190, 191-2, 191-3 of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita and under Sections 4/25 of the Arms Act, the applicant Shaikh Adil Raunak be released on bail on furnishing PR Bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- , with one or more sureties in the like amount, on the following conditions :-

[i] The applicant shall attend the concerned police station and report to the Investigating Officer on every Sunday starting from 10th May, 2026, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. until further orders and shall cooperate with the investigation.

[ii] The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.

[iii] The applicant shall submit his Aadhar card and Pan card to the Investigating Officer alongwith mobile numbers and addresses of two of his near relatives.

[iv] Stand over to 22nd June, 2026.
