1. The applicant has approached this Court seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Crime No.121 of 2025, registered with Ajintha Police District. Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, for the offences punishable U/Sec. 316-2, 318-2, 318-3, 318-4, 61-2 r/w 3-5 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and U/Sec. 3 & 4 of the M.P.I.D. Act, 2019 and U/Sec. 21 & 22 of the Banning of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Act, 2019.

2. Heard Mr. Magar, the learned counsel for the applicant. Issue notice to respondents returnable on 17th June, 2026. Learned APP waives notice for State.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant Mr. Magar submits that the other co accused have already been released on anticipatory bail. Even though there are serious allegation against her husband of misappropriation of funds, he was protected by this Court. The only allegation against the applicant Director is of withdrawal of Rs. 50,000/- on 18.11.2025 and Rs. 1,00,000/- on 4.9.2025. The applicant is ready to show his bonafides for depositing an amount of Rs. 1 Lakh. The

applicant is not having any criminal antecedents and is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. The applicant is suffering from serious ailment and is required to undergo operation. The earlier application was withdrawn by the applicant only in view of the fact that the charge sheet came to be filed. There was no adjudication on merits in the earlier bail application bearing ABA No. 1237 of 2025 filed by the applicant.

3. Thus, taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions and the fact that the applicant is ready to deposit an amount of Rs. 1 Lakhs, I am inclined to protect the applicant till the investigation papers are seen. Hence, the following order :-

ORDER

[I] In the event of arrest of the applicant, in connection with Crime No. 121 of 2025, registered with Ajintha Police District. Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, for the offences punishable U/Sec. 316-2, 318-2, 318-3, 318-4, 61-2 r/w 3-5 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and U/Sec. 3 & 4 of the M.P.I.D. Act and U/Sec. 21 & 22 of the Banning of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Act, 2019, the applicant Bhausahab Rangnath Kakde, be released on bail on furnishing PR Bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/-, with one or more sureties in the like amount, on the following conditions :-

[i] The applicant shall attend the concerned police station and report to the Investigating Officer on every Sunday starting from 10th May, 2026, between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. until further orders and shall cooperate with the investigation.

[ii] The aforesaid interim order is subject to applicant depositing an amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- within a period of

five weeks from today.

[iii] Failure on the part of the applicant to deposit the amount within stipulated time, shall result in vacation of the interim relief.

[ii] The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.

[iii] The applicant shall submit his Passport, Aadhar and Pan card to the Investigating Officer alongwith mobile numbers and addresses of two of his near relatives.

[iv] Stand over to 17th June, 2026.
