ORDER :

. Heard both sides.

2. Applicants are seeking enlargement on bail in respect of offence bearing Cr. No. 128/2026 registered with Kaij Police Station, Tq. Kaij, Dist. Beed for the offences punishable U/Sec. 109, 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 189(2), 190, 191(2), 191(3), 352 and 351(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. Applicant No. 1 is arrested on 16.04.2026.

3. On mentioning this matter is specifically kept in the second session as there is exigency for the applicant No. 1. His examination of I Year of D. Pharmacy is scheduled from

30.04.2026 to 16.05.2026. A copy of time table is annexed with the application. It is informed that he has missed the examination for the subjects of Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Pharmacognosy which were held on 30.04.2026 and 05.05.2026. He is desirous of appearing for the remaining papers from 08.05.2026 onwards.

4. Learned A. P. P. would point out that he is involved in serious offence. He is likely to misuse the bail.

5. Issue notice to the respondent. Learned A. P. P. waives notice for the respondent – State. Call for the papers from the concern police station. List this matter on 15.06.2026.

6. A case is made out to grant bail to enable the applicant to appear for examination. The matter on merits shall be dealt with on the next date.

7. The applicant shall be released on temporary bail in Cr. No. 128/2026 registered with Kaij Police Station, Tq. Kaij, Dist. Beed for the offences punishable U/Sec. 109, 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 189(2), 190, 191(2), 191(3), 352 and 351(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 on condition of furnishing P. R. bond and S. B. of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five thousands only) with one solvent surety of like amount.

8. The applicant shall not tamper with prosecution evidence

or contact with the prosecution witnesses.

9. The applicant shall report the concern police station on 17.05.2026.

10. The applicant shall surrender the bail on 18.05.2026.

11. Any misuse of liberty shall be taken seriously.

12. Parties shall act upon authenticated copy.
