**PER COURT :**

1. Heard the learned counsel for the Applicant and the learned APP for the Respondent – State.
2. The applicant apprehend arrest in connection with Crime No.0076 of 2024, dated 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024, registered with Gandhi Chowk Police Station, Dist. Latur, for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 409, 420, 201, 465, 467, 468, 471 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of the MPID Act.
3. Issue notice to the Respondent, returnable on **25<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.

4. Learned APP waives service of notice on behalf of the respondent – State.

5. Considering the allegations made in the FIR and the role attributed to the applicant, the applicant has prima facie made out a case for grant of interim protection. Therefore, I am inclined to grant interim protection to the applicant. Hence, the following order.

### ORDER

- (a) Till the next date, in the event of arrest of the applicant – Premkishor Mathuradas Mundada in connection with Crime No.0076 of 2024, dated 14<sup>th</sup> February 2024, registered with Gandhi Chowki Police Station, Dist. Latur, for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 409, 420, 201, 465, 467, 468, 471 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code, and Sections 3 and 4 of the MPID Act, he be released on bail on executing P.R. Bond and Surety Bond of ₹ 15,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.
- (b) The applicant shall attend the concerned police station on every Saturday and Sunday between 10:00 a.m. and 02:00 p.m. till the next date.

- (c) The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner whatsoever.
- (d) The applicant shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency.
