1. Heard the learned Advocate for the applicants and the learned
APP for the State.

2. The applicants apprehend arrest in connection with Crime
No.0840/2025, registered with MIDC Police Station, Dist. Ahilyanagar,
for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 417, 465, 466, 467,
468, 471, 406, 34, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 03.07.2026.
Learned APP waives service of notice for the respondent nos.1 and 2 –
State.

4. Considering the allegations made in the FIR and the role attributed to the applicants, the applicants have *prima facie* made out a case for grant of interim protection. Therefore, I am inclined to grant interim protection to the applicants. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Till the next date, in the event of arrest of the applicants, namely, 1. Vaishali Lawrence Swami, 2. Minal Vincent Swami in connection with Crime No.0840/2025, registered with MIDC Police Station, Dist. Ahilyanagar, for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 417, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 406, 34, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, be released on bail on executing P.R. Bond of Rs.15,000/- [Rupees Fifteen Thousand] each, with one surety in the like amount each.
- (ii) The applicants shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Saturday and Tuesday between 10.00 a.m. and 02.00 p.m. till the next date.
- (iii) The applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner whatsoever.
- (iv) The applicants shall cooperate with the Investigating Agency.
