**PER COURT :**

1. The Petitioners suffered an order under Section 5 of the Mamlatdar Courts Act, which has been confirmed by the Sub-Divisional Officer in Revision filed under Section 23(2) of the Mamlatdar Courts Act. The Petitioners have now been served with a notice for execution of the said order by the Circle Officer, Dhor-Jalgaon, Taluka Shevgaon, District Ahilyanagar. The execution of the order is proposed on 02.06.2026 at 11:00 a.m.

2. Perused the grounds of the petition and the reasoning adopted by the authorities under the Mamlatdar Courts Act. Prima facie, looking to the application previously filed by the Respondents for relief, it appears that the so-called obstruction was in existence since long. However, the Mamlatdar has not examined the issue of limitation in its proper perspective.

3. In that view of the matter, issue notice to Respondents, returnable on 24.06.2026. Learned AGP waives service of notice for Respondent Nos. 1 and 2.

4. In addition to Court notice, Petitioners shall be at liberty to serve

Respondent nos.3 to 5 by any other alternate mode as is permissible under law and file affidavit of service before returnable date.

5. Till the returnable date, the execution of the impugned order, vide communication dated 21.05.2026 issued by the Circle Officer, Dhor-Jalgaon, Shevgaon, District Ahilyanagar, shall be kept in abeyance.
