2. Mr.Choudhari, learned counsel for the petitioner, would submit that the order passed by the authorities under Section 5(2) of the Mamlatdar's Court Act is against the petitioner. The challenge to the said order under Section 23 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code has also been turned down by the authority. The petitioner's apprehension is that tomorrow, i.e. on 03.06.2026, the authority would implement the order passed by the Mamlatdar's Court and will carve out a road or way through his field.

3. Issue notice to the respondents returnable on 17.06.2026. Learned AGP waives notice for the respondent nos.1 to 3. The

petitioner may additionally serve respondent nos.4 and 5 by a permissible mode of private service. Humdast allowed.
