PER COURT :

1. Mr. Sujit Patil, learned Advocate appearing for petitioner submits that petitioner has suffered the order dated 13.03.2026 passed under section 143 of The Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966 (for short "*MLR Code*"). The petitioner has assailed said order before Sub Divisional Officer in Appeal No.2026/ROR/A-59 under section 247 of the MLR Code. The petitioner has also filed an application for stay to order impugned. However, pending decision of appeal or application for stay, the execution of order passed under section 143 of MLR Code by Tahsildar is undertaken and is scheduled for today. He points out that learned Sub Divisional Officer has posted appeal for hearing on 14.07.2026 without hearing petitioner's application for stay to order impugned.

2. In light of submissions advanced, issue notice to respondents, returnable on 06.07.2026. Learned AGP waives notice for respondent nos.1 to 4.

3. Till returnable date, there shall be ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause (D).

4. Needless to state here that, learned Sub Divisional Officer may decide petitioner's application for stay without influenced by present order.

5. Learned AGP to communicate this order to concerned authority.
